Dear Faith partners,

Greetings in the precious name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. I thank God for giving me the privilege to share with you how things are going on in C.C.M orphanage. I whole heartedly thank each and every one for your generous contribution for C.C.M .In sponsoring the children and being their guard parents as well as for buying the land.



God's plans are different they are above mans imagination. **As He said in Jeremiah 29;11 'For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and future.** God blessed our little orphanage in getting the land. It would be impossible without your prayers and financial help. There are tears of gratitude in each and every orphan eye for helping us to have our own land. I don't know how to thank you.

**LAND** :-We got the 4 acres of land registered in Compassion Clement Mission's name in the month of April. We had to pay some loans to some of our friends, but we took some more time from them because we needed to start the construction as soon as possible. We first drilled deep well on the land but we did not get any water. There was stone and all we got is the stone powder so we decided to call a geologist to tell us where we can drill a well. He gave us 2 places to drill and we still did not get any water. We were very much disappointed and discouraged but this time we decided to drill once again and again we prayed and drilled for the water and we got sweet drinking water at 40 feet. We jumped with joy for what God has done. This water is sufficient for every thing like construction, cultivation and for daily use.

**Construction**:- Then we started to hook up electric. Unless we have power we cannot run the bore well so, the connection was given but we have very less voltage. To have good voltage we need to have an electrical transformer which will cost at least \$ 5,000. With the little voltage we started to dig for the basement. We hired the workers for the temporary building. We planned to have 10 rooms and a combination prayer and dining hall. We bought sand, stone and cement and finished the basement and filled it with filling sand.



As we don't have enough money for the construction and payment to the labour many a times the work stopped. And the workers, who don't want to waste their time, search for another job. When we go to them and say we have money please come and finish the work, they say they have to finish the other job and then come back.

**Support:** - The most important need is financial help. If we have the money in our hand then the work will not stop. We can finish it within 2 months. And we will be able to celebrate Christmas in our own orphanage. Next process of construction is we need to start the brick work, fix wooden doors and windows and put cement sheets for the roof and finish cement plastering. We also need to construct toilets for the children. We need to put a compound wall and buy a transformer. The money that is coming through Trinity India Mission is being used for the construction purpose.
